



Adjustments to drop-off and pick-up Week 2

Dear parents and carers,

Drop-off and pick-up during Week 1 has been very smooth. Each day the routines have flowed better and as a school we are very appreciative of the care and patience everyone has shown.

At the start of Week 2 there is the possibility of significant rain. To plan for the rain, and a likely increase in the number of children arriving by car, the following adjustments will be made. If you change the drop-off or pick-up method for your child, please tell them and contact their class teacher via Connect or email.

Morning drop-off (Gates open at 8:15 am):

Arriving by car:

- Parents can assist their child with their seat belts, especially for the younger children who are still in harnessed car seats or booster seats. If you need to get out of your driver seat to do this that is okay.
- Once your child is out of the car they will make their way to class by themselves as usual.
- Parents will get back into their car and drive off carefully.

Arriving by bicycle or walking:

- There will be no changes to this process.

Afternoon pick-up (Gates open at 2:25 pm):

Leaving by car:

- If it is raining children will be under the following verandas where they can see cars arriving at the Kiss and Drive areas.
 - Bodley Road – Pre-primary veranda over-looking the carpark.
 - Summerville Boulevard – Veranda in front of Wornt 3 and 4 where they can see the carpark.
- Parents can assist their child with their seat belts, especially for the younger children who are still in harnessed car seats or booster seats. If you need to get out of your driver seat to do this that is okay.
- Parents are not to move away from their cars to collect children.

Arriving by bicycle or walking:

- There will be no changes to this process.
