

## Structure of a typical school day

Most school days will follow the same, or a similar, structure. There will be some variations due to factors such as specialist subjects, excursions, assemblies, camps, specials events such as NAIDOC Week or Science week.

The following outlines what would constitute a typical school day:

- **8:15 am** – Classroom doors open. Students are to enter class and prepare for the day. Classroom teacher is preparing for the day and no formal teaching is occurring.
- **8:30 am** – School lessons officially start. Classes begin with 20 minute ‘Morning Meeting’ (see ‘Morning Meeting’ information).
- **8:50 am – 10:30 am** – Literacy or Numeracy block.
- **10:30 am – 10:50 am** – Morning break/recess.
- **10:50 am – 12:30 pm** – Literacy or Numeracy block.
- **12:30 pm – 12:55 pm** – Lunch – Play.
- **12:55 pm – 1:10 pm** – Lunch – Eating.
- **1:10 pm – 2:40 pm** – Other curriculum learning areas.

Classrooms teachers will outline in greater detail what children will be learning and when. Caversham Valley PS attempts to minimise all disruptions during class times to maximise the learning opportunities for all.
